



## JUNIOR HIGH MATH TEACHER

**Position Requirements:** Candidates will be expected to have an undergraduate and/or advanced degree in mathematics or a related field, a commitment to innovative teaching methods, and an enthusiasm for teaching within a diverse community of learners. Applicants with prior teaching experience, interest in and experience with STEM or Maker Spaces and/or the ability to coach a sport will be given special consideration.

**Responsibilities will include:**

- Teaching multiple sections of twelve to fifteen students
- Participating in departmental planning and curricular review
- Serving as an advisor/mentor
- Assisting with evening and weekend campus activities and supervision
- Coaching and/or teaching an afternoon program

**Compensation:** This is a full-time, academic year position. Salary is dependent on education and experience; teachers are given salary credit for teaching experience. Benefits include a tuition remission plan, health and dental insurance, worker's compensation, short-term and long-term disability, group life insurance, retirement plan, and eligibility for professional enrichment and continuing education.
