## Dear Parents and Guardians:

Thank you so much for your support this school year. We have seen many of your children make amazing strides in math thanks to your encouragement.

By fostering a positive approach to the completion of the summer math assignment, you will help your child learn and retain important math skills and concepts. Your cooperation in assuring that the summer work is completed will contribute to your child's future success in school.

While most students should be able to complete the lessons independently, some students may need help in managing their time and some skills. Students are expected to finish problems for lessons 1-20 from Saxon Math 5. This summer's math work will be the "Written Practice" of the following lessons (see below) from Saxon Math Intermediate 5. Your student is not required to do all 20 lessons, although they are more than welcome to!

## Saxon 5 Written Practice from Lessons: 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 13, 14, 16, 18 and 19.

They should bring the completed assignment with them on the first day of school in August.

At the beginning of the school year, teachers will review and analyze the students' work. Both strengths and weaknesses will be identified. In this way your child's teachers can most effectively design instruction that meets the needs of the students.
