Thank you so much for your support this school year. I have seen many of your children make amazing strides in math thanks to your encouragement! To be best prepared for Glencoe Algebra 1 when they return in August, students should have mastery of the following prerequisite skills:

- 1. Find and use fraction-decimal-percent equivalents
- 2. Determine area, surface area, and volume of various geometric figures
- 3. Write & solve proportions
- 4. Translate words into algebraic expressions and equations

This summer's math assignment can be found on the SBA website. Please go to www.stbernard.org and select the 2020 Summer Work under the Academics > Curriculum menu. There you will choose the "AP Math Login Instructions" pdf which contains the "ConnectED log-in instructions". After your child opens the pdf, he or she will follow the "If You Have A Username or Password" directions using the username and password that you received in my recent email. The assignment is to complete the Chapter 0 (zero) exercises. There are 13 Lessons in Ch.0 beginning on page P5 through page P46. Complete the EVEN numbered problems only. This is designed to be a review and includes many of the prerequisite skills for Glencoe Algebra 1. This is the first homework assignment due upon their return in August. Additionally, during the first week of school your child will take a written assessment to determine his or her mastery of these concepts.
