E-Safety Agreement

- ❖ One-on-one interactions are strictly prohibited. In the event that only one student is available for a virtual session with the instructor, the session will be immediately terminated, and the Summer Play Days Director will be informed at once. The terminated session can begin again if/when the student’s parent, guardian, or the Director can be present.
- ❖ Cyber-bullying will not be tolerated under any circumstances. If cyber-bullying is suspected by any party, the Director will be notified immediately for further investigation.

Prepare to create your own superhero secret identity, as we build strength in our bodies, take flight in upside-down poses, and discover our own magical sidekicks. Each day, you'll learn new yoga movement, games, and breath that leave you feeling empowered and brave! We provide the content and you can go at your own pace!

In this virtual camp, your camper will receive:

- **An At-Home Camp Kit** filled with all of the supplies the camper will need for their yoga classes and craft projects.*
- **A Printed Camp Guide** detailing each day of camp and answering any questions for parents and campers. Parents will also receive all online links a few days before the start of camp in a welcome email.
- **Daily 25-minute Zoom Calls** with the camper's yoga teacher. The Zoom calls will be scheduled at the same time every day. We hope they will give all campers an opportunity to see their friends, connect with their teacher, play group games and activities, and share their daily crafts and feedback.
- **Daily 45-minute to 1-hour Recorded Yoga Videos**, full of poses, sequences, games, songs, breath work, and meditations that each camper can follow along with and do at home.
- **Daily At-Home Challenges** that each camper can perform on their own time, inside the house or outdoors! These fun challenges include scavenger hunts, mindfulness activities, and outside play.
- **A Daily Craft Project** with a prerecorded video, so that each camper can follow along with their instructor and complete their craft – no direct parent supervision needed!**

** Each camper will need to provide their own yoga mat (optional), coloring utensils of their choice, scissors, and a small stuffed animal. Other than that, we'll include everything they need!*

***If parents or siblings would like to do yoga and crafts along with the camper, you can purchase an additional At-Home Camp Kit for \$75.*
